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Methodology: face-to-face

1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS

More than half of the respondents in the Netherlands believe that climate change is a “very serious” problem (58%, no change since 2013). They are more likely to say that they themselves are responsible for tackling climate change than in any other Member State (43%, EU average: 19%).

The proportion saying that they have taken personal action to fight climate change in the past six months is close to the average (47%, compared with an EU average of 49%). However, when presented with a list of specific activities, the figure rises to 97%, showing that many people do not connect certain actions with tackling climate change. Practical measures taken include:

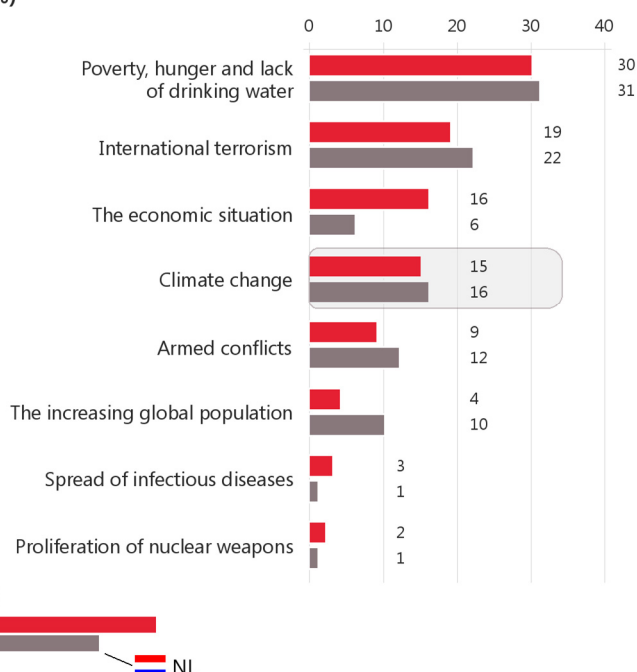
- Trying to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (84%, +9 percentage points since 2013)
- Trying to cut down consumption of disposable items (72%, +11 percentage points since 2013)
- Using environmentally-friendly alternatives to the car (59%, compared to the EU average of 36%)

Almost nine in ten respondents (89%) agree that fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together.

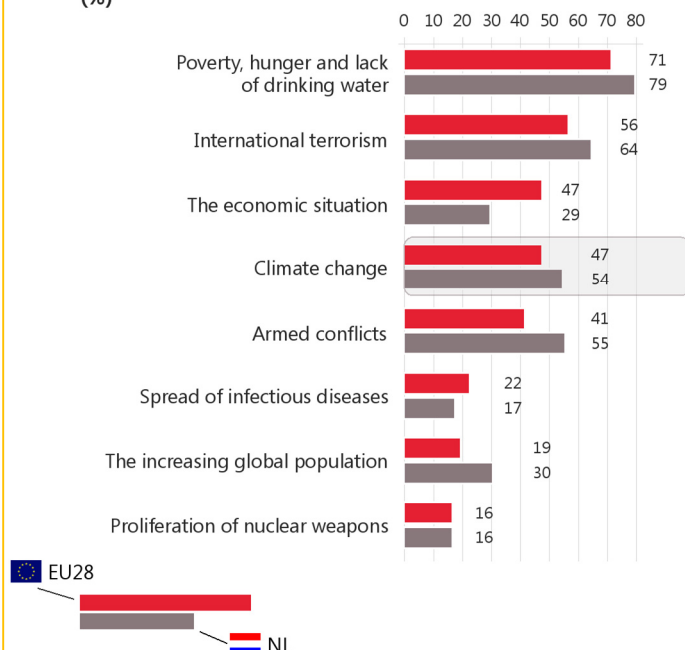
A large majority support national action to increase the use of renewable energy (97%) and provide support for improving energy efficiency by 2030 (95%).

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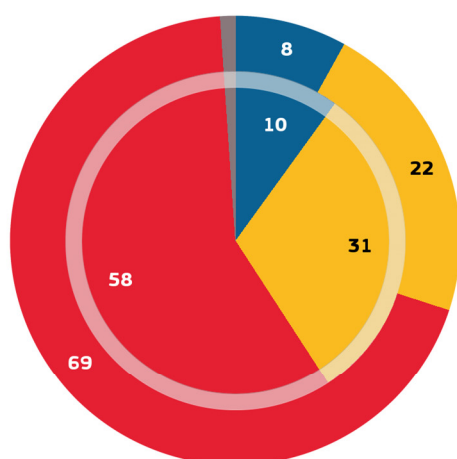

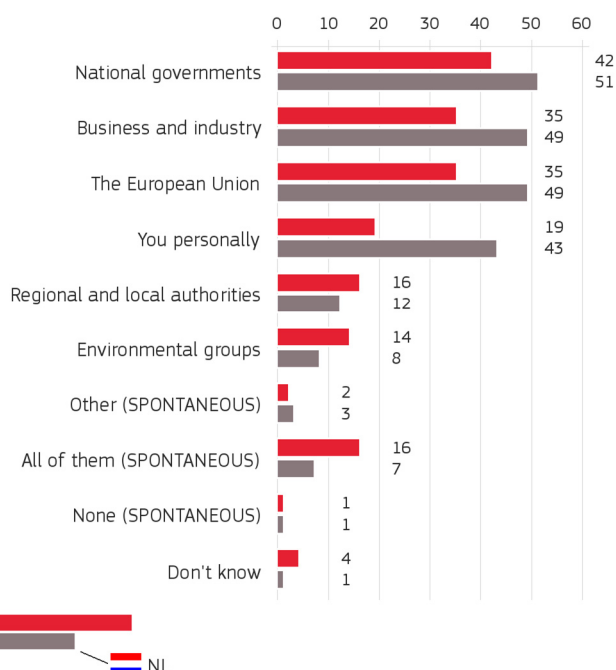

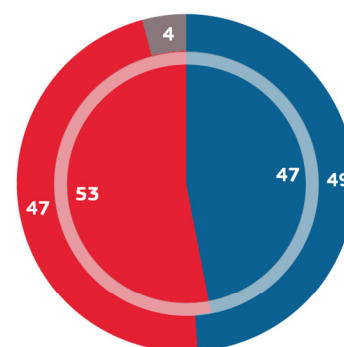
QA3 In your opinion, who within the EU is responsible for tackling climate change? (MULTIPLE ANSWERS POSSIBLE)

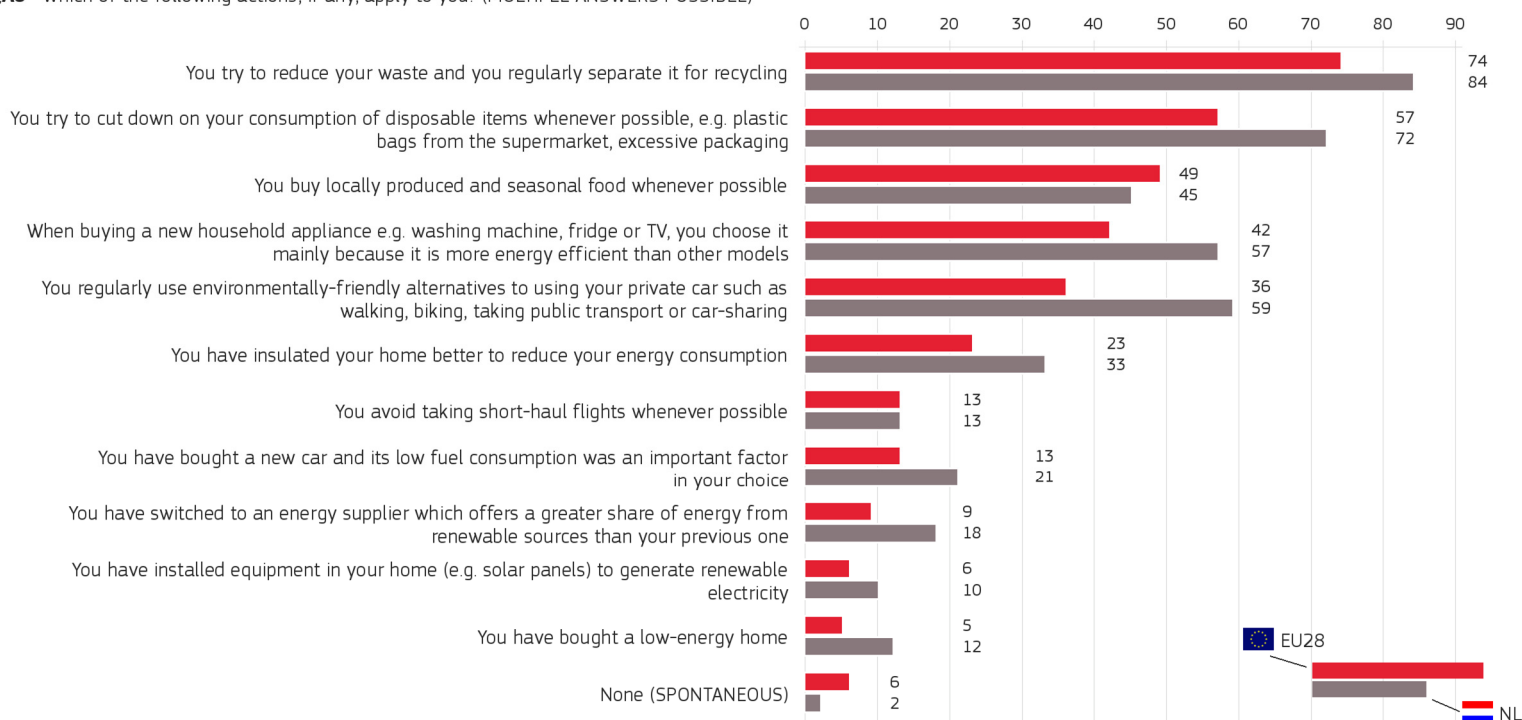

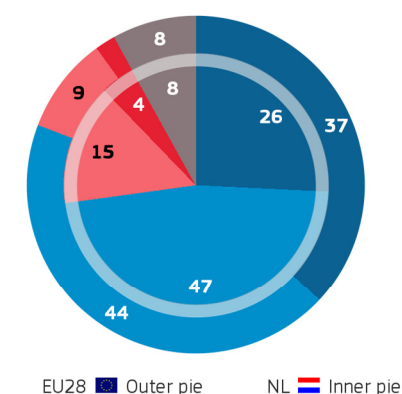
QA6 Which of the following actions, if any, apply to you? (MULTIPLE ANSWERS POSSIBLE)

Fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and jobs in the EU (%)

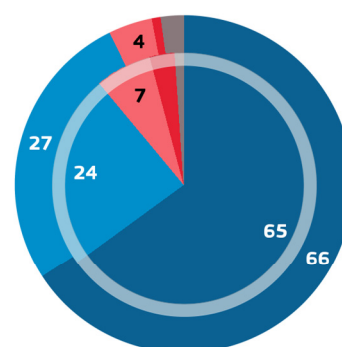

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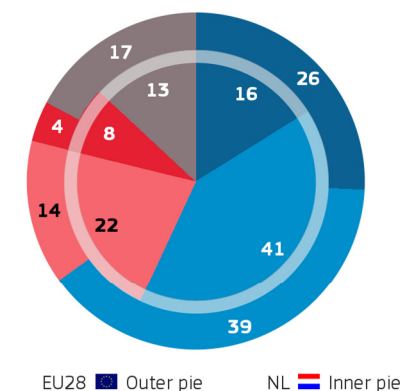

Reducing fossil fuel imports from outside the EU can benefit the EU economically (%)

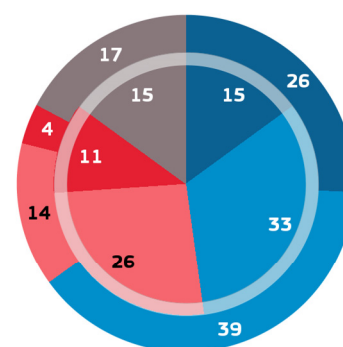

Reducing fossil fuel imports from outside the EU can increase the security of EU energy supplies (%)

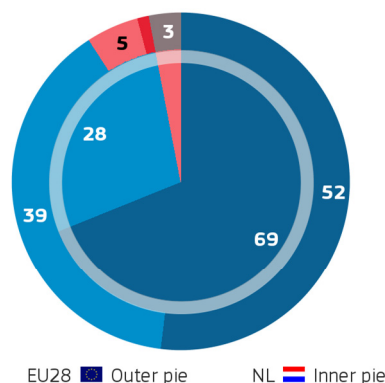

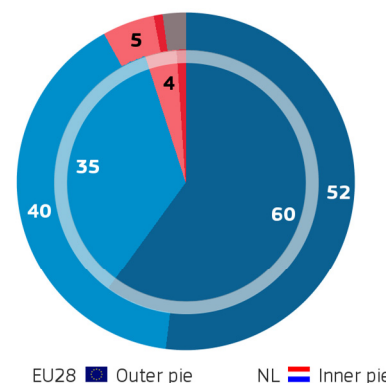
QA7 How important do you think it is that the (NATIONALITY) government sets targets to increase the amount of renewable energy used, such as wind or solar power, by 2030? (%)
